The Goat Ladies offers eco-friendly, highly effective goat grazing services for invasive weed control, weed mitigation, riverbank clearing, pasture rejuvenation, and land restoration projects. Our grazing herds naturally remove unwanted vegetation, reduce fuel loads, improve soil health, and help restore ecological balance—without chemicals or heavy machinery.

Many of the services we provide may qualify for financial assistance through the Laramie River Conservation District's Rural Cost Share Program, which reimburses landowners for approved Best Management Practices (BMPs) such as weed mitigation and land improvement. ### HOW WE CAN HELP LANDOWNERS

We work directly with property owners to:

- Identify invasive plants and areas needing clearing
- Develop a customized goat-grazing plan
- Provide documentation and estimates that can support cost-share applications
- Complete the vegetation management project efficiently and safely

Under LRCD's program, eligible landowners may receive up to 50% reimbursement (up to \$7,500) after project completion, making goat grazing a cost-effective solution for land management.
