Each grazing project is customized based on acreage, terrain, vegetation density, accessibility, fencing needs, and project duration.

### **General Grazing Information**

- Approximately 50 goats can clear up to 1 Wyoming acre during a standard 8-hour grazing period under average conditions.
- Larger herds may be utilized for accelerated project completion.
- Goats are ideal for steep terrain, uneven ground, rocky areas, riverbanks, and locations difficult to access with machinery.

Targeted grazing is effective for:

- Weed control
- Brush reduction
- Fire mitigation
- Invasive plant management
- Overgrown properties
- Difficult terrain and slopes
- Environmentally sensitive areas

### **Service Pricing Guide**

#### **Standard 8-Hour Grazing Service**

##### **50-Goat Herd**

Starting at \$800 + travel

Includes:

- Herd transportation
- Temporary fencing systems
- Water systems
- Herd supervision and monitoring
- Predator protection
- Site setup and teardown

Typical setup and teardown for single-day projects requires approximately 1–1.5 hours total.

#### **Multi-Day / 24-Hour Grazing Service**

##### **50-Goat Herd**

Starting at \$1,000 per day

Recommended for:

- Larger properties
- Heavy vegetation
- Fire mitigation projects
- Extended vegetation management

#### **Expanded Herd Grazing Service**

##### **100-Goat Herd**

Starting at \$1,500 per day

Please Note:

- Requires two transport trips
- Available for projects lasting 3 or more consecutive days

- Ideal for larger acreage and faster project completion

### **Travel & Extended Grazing Information**

- Travel fees apply to projects lasting fewer than 3 consecutive days.
- Projects lasting 3 or more consecutive days include no travel fee.
- Multi-day projects are commonly established using a rotational “daisy pattern” grazing system for efficient vegetation management.
- Larger project setup and teardown generally require approximately 2–3 hours.
- Grazing systems may remain onsite for up to 3 weeks depending on project scope and vegetation goals.

### **Foster Grazing Program**

We also offer a limited foster grazing program for approved participants interested in fostering between 2–6 goats.

Equipment rental packages, including fencing and setup assistance, are available for foster participants.
